Subject: Request for check of weapon/tracing delivery history of
handgun.

On 28 February 1986 the Swedish Prime Minister Olof Palme was assassinated at the Tunnelgatan-Sveavagen intersection in Stockholm. Mr Palme was killed by a calibre .375 Magnum bullet fired from a revolver. The murder remains unsolved to date and the murder weapon has not been recovered. One of the models possibly used is a Smith & Wesson .357 Magnum revolver.

Investigations revealed that a 27 model Smith & Wesson, calibre .357 Magnum with a 6 inch barrel was owned by a Swedish national at the time of the murder. The serial number is N694274.

When questioned by police this Swede said he had sold the weapon to a person unknown. The weapon has not been recovered. It has therefore not been possible to carry out a test shooting for comparison between the test bullets and the bullets found at the scene of the murder.

Mr. George M. Hood, Smith & Wesson, Springfield Massachusetts, USA, advised the Swedish Smith & Wesson general agent, Lexne AB, that his company on or about 4 February 1980 delivered the 27 Model with a 6 inch barrel, serial number N694274 with freight order H35959 to Jonas Aircraft & Arms Company 120 Wall Street, New York NY 1005.

As the subsequent history of this weapon is not known could you please assist us in determining which persons/companies were registered owners of this wapon and to whom it was delivered when exported from the USA.
