Dear Stig.

The time flies; our last contact -by phone- dates back to mid-June, after our meeting in March and my letter and fax in April.

As I told you before I'm still very passionate -especially as a former police-commissioner, who investigated the Bilgill-murders- to come to know the truth about my case, your case and the possible link between the two incidents. My passion comes from my belief in the analysis I made and the lax attitude of the Dutch authorities after presenting my study-results.

The striking thing in that attitude is that they all were very positive about my report but refused to take initiatives (leading to further investigation) or referred to the responsibility of others!

That situation made me undertake other steps. During several periods I worked together with the press (papers/ magazines/ TV).

Just before I came into contact with you I was in an advanced stadium of cooperation with a prominent Dutch-TV current affairs programme called NETWERK (KRO).

I emphasize that I immediately stopped that cooperation (temporarily?) in the interest of our meeting and further appointments/agreements.
